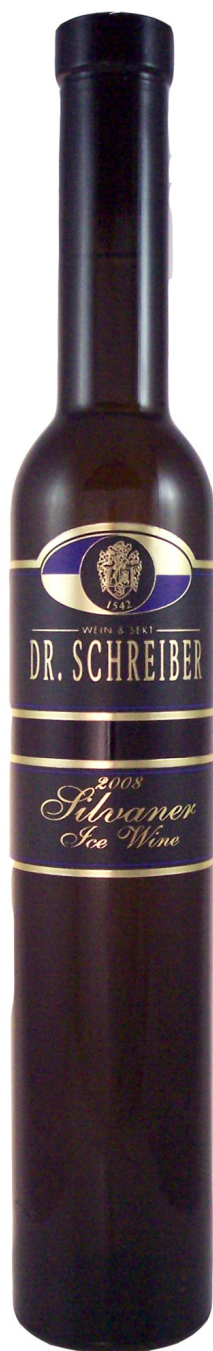


# ICE WINE

## WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Ice Wine is a type of dessert wine produced from grapes that have been frozen while still on the vine. The sugars and other dissolved solids do not freeze, but the water does, so the result is a concentrated, often very sweet wine. In the case of ice wines, the freezing happens before the fermentation, not afterwards. Only healthy grapes in good shape are kept until the opportunity for ice wine harvest. This gives ice wine its characteristic refreshing sweetness balanced by high acidity.

## TASTING NOTES

Ice wine has a medium to full body, with a long lingering finish. The nose is usually reminiscent of peach, pear, dried apricot, honey, citrus, figs, caramel, green apple, etc., depending on the varietal. The aroma of tropical and exotic fruits such as pineapple, mango, or lychee is quite common.

## FOOD PAIRINGS

This sweet nectar is aromatic, sweet with a clean finish, excellent with dessert or after dinner.
