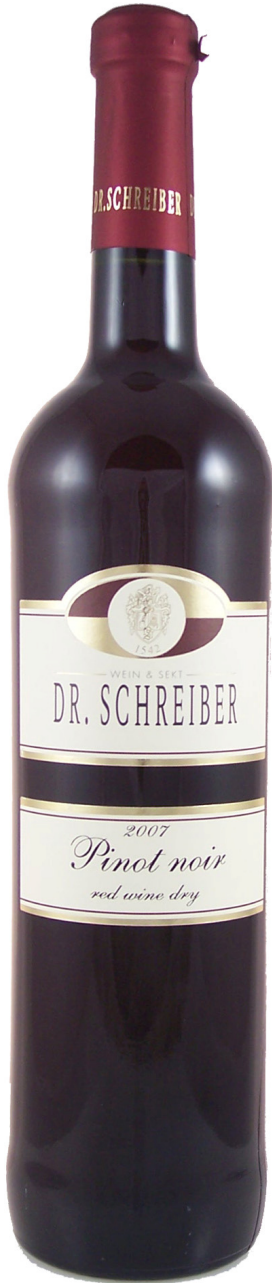

## TASTING NOTES

This is the most demanding black grape variety in Germany. Red wines from Pinot Noir can be called the aristocrats of red wines. They have a full flavor they are smooth, have much body, and are high in alcohol and are of a pale red to ruby red color typical for Pinot Noir.

This mouth-filling velvety smooth wine yields a slightly sweet, fruity aroma. Perfect with elegant roasts and game.
